## Powers and Duties of the School Board

Special Charter, approved February 16, 1865

- 1. Provide common schooling for all persons residing within the District between the ages of five years and twenty-one years, for not less than eight months of each year.
- 2. Control all school houses, school lots and school property within the District.
- 3. Purchase lots for the erection of school houses.
- 4. Build or lease buildings for schools.
- 5. Keep schools in repair.
- 6. Furnish schools with necessary fixtures, furniture, books, apparatus, and libraries.
- 7. Sell real estate that has become unnecessary, unsuitable, or inconvenient.
- 8. Appoint all teachers, fix teachers' salaries or compensation, and may dismiss teachers at any time.
- 9. Direct what branches of learning shall be taught and what books shall be used.
- 10. Establish schools or departments of different grades.
- 11. Direct the examination of students for passing students from grade to grade.
- 12. Graduate students.
- 13. Make all necessary rules and regulations for the admission of students.
- 14. Make all necessary rules and regulations for the government of the schools and district.
- 15. Suspend or expel students.
- 16. Appoint agents and servants for any matter
